Periodically during this period of the pandemic, governments at the provincial and federal levels have invited representatives of faith groups to a briefing or a consultation about evolving conditions. The Bahá'í community has been represented at these useful events. At a recent gathering with national public health officials on the subject of vaccination, an informational toolkit was shared, and a follow-up letter asked those who had been present to share it with their communities as a service.
